THE ANCIENT ART OF RAKU!

For ages 8 and up – 4 sessions available

RAKU was first employed in 16th century Japan for bowls made for the Japanese tea ceremony. We will spend the week working with this ancient firing process. Using a Raku clay body, we will focus on wheel-throwing, hand building, and sculptural techniques. While the objects are firing in the Raku kiln on Thursday & Friday, each “artist-in-residence” will create their own unique, *handmade* Adobe architectural sculpture.

This week will provide an exciting way for attendees to explore their creativity while they learn the crafts of clay and Adobe. The week will consist of instruction in the clay techniques of wheel-throwing, hand-building and sculptural techniques. On Thursday & Friday, each “artist-in-residence” will create their own unique, *handmade* Adobe architectural sculpture in addition to completing their clay projects.

WET CLAY classes for kids!

Classes meet for 1¼ hours. Each participant works on a project from their own imagination (*we have exclusive reference materials to serve as their “muse” if needed!*).

Each student works at their own pace. Instructors assist in learning pottery wheel throwing, hand building, sculpting, under glazing (painting), clear glazing and dip glazing. A high ratio of instructors to students insures personal attention as the children explore their creativity and work toward project completion.

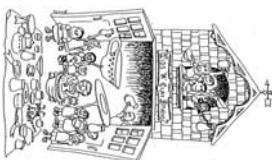

**Safety and

The staff of Kids 'N' Clay takes extraordinary precautions to ensure the safety and well-being of the students. Parents are expected to oversee the safety of their student(s) during the arrival and departure to and from the studio space. A high level of supervision is given the students while working.

However, ceramics does involve some mechanical devices (e.g. pottery wheels) and equipment (scoring pins, rolling pins, non-toxic glazes, etc.) that could present a hazard if used improperly. Like many other materials, extended exposure to excessive clay dust may present a health hazard. Please be assured that daily efforts are undertaken at Kids 'N' Clay to reduce the presence of clay dust, such as daily HEPA vacuuming and a wash down of affected hard surfaces and floors.

Involvement in these classes constitutes an acknowledgement by the sponsoring party(ies) that they are aware of some inherent risk to their children in these classes and agree to hold Kids 'N' Clay harmless, without condition or limitation, in the event of any injury or harm to their student(s).
